A Word from Our Pastor

Greetings Paragould First United Methodist Church,

What an encouraging summer of shared ministry at Paragould First United Methodist Church! Vacation Bible School "Hero Hotline" was one of the most fun and smoothest VBSs ever! Thanks to Children's Director Angela Newby, families and children of the church, and countless volunteers for an awesome week! At the same time, some youth and adult chaperone, Jeani Wallace, were working hard around Forrest City & Wynne serving neighbors in need through Ozark Mission Project. Upon their return, I heard stories of fun and fellowship, service and care. Danielle Honeycutt and Angela lead a busy and exciting week of Ready, Set, READ! where community elementary students grew in their literacy skills. So great to see our church host such an encouraging ministry. Thanks to everyone who joined the "Bach Mobile" concert with Louis Menendez in the Worship Center. It's so nice to share a church that values the fine arts.



We are thrilled to welcome FUMC's new Assoc. Pastor, Sarah Ellzey. Sarah's seminary degree is from Truett Theological Seminary at Baylor University. Sarah's background, skills, and focus are a great fit for FUMC. She has experience in counseling, preaching, and missions/service work. Sarah is pursuing ordination in the Arkansas Conference of the United Methodist Church. Pastor Sarah is off to a fast start, including helping lead worship, working closely with pastoral care, and will soon get more involved with the Missions and Hospitality teams. One particular effort I am enthusiastic about is a new adult Sunday School class under Sarah's guidance-beginning Sept. 10!

FUMC celebrated an Open House for the newly renovated first-floor office suite on Sunday, June 4. The new space is wonderful and working well. The new offices include Senior Pastor, Associate Pastor, Communications Director, Church Administrator, Children's & Youth Director (shared), Media Room, Conference Room, and Copy/Work Room! Some other changes include the "Pairs & Spares" class returning to their Welcome Center Classroom. The "Sisters in Spirit" class now meets in Karoline's former office in the Welcome Center. Music Director Brian Pearson now offices in the former Senior Pastor's office on the second floor outside the Choir Room. Thanks to everyone for their support for this important project, as it is already paying dividends. Stop by anytime!

Another transition that came along with the new office space was relocating the FUMC Library to the First Floor Welcome Center (Denise's old office). I am thrilled to have the Library more accessible. The church owns lots of great material including Biblical reference, curriculum, and theological texts. Stop and browse

anytime. You may take and return books on an honor system. With respect to curriculum, FUMC owns many versions with multiple copies for small group studies. And the Library includes a wonderful conference table and chairs - great for many classes and meetings.

The Next 100 Years campaign began last May with a five-year plan to pay off our construction debt and tackle a couple of necessary facility improvements. One of those projects was the first-floor office suite with a budget of \$200k. This project was completed on time and at budget. We still plan to take on a few issues in the Sanctuary including paint/plaster maintenance (funds secured) and technology upgrades. We have reduced our debt from \$3.19m last Spring to \$2.7m as of today. Thank you for your constant support of your church, including the financial needs of the Next 100 Years Campaign! You can see campaign updates online at fumcparagould.org/100years.

As of June, this year's general giving totals \$416k compared to \$421k at this point last year. General expenses year-to-date are \$469k vs. \$426k last year. Giving is nearly the same, while expenses are up about 10%. The increased expenses are not unique to the church as the economic trends have led to greater costs. Plus, the church has incurred a number of unanticipated expenses, including necessary maintenance projects. It is not uncommon for expenses to run ahead of giving through most of the year as we tend to receive our greatest gifts in the final month of the year. Still yet, we do not want the difference between giving and expenses to grow too large. The FUMC Staff & Finance Committee will be cautious with spending in the days ahead. You can give any Sunday, by mail, electronic transfer, or online at fumcparagould.org/giving.html. Thank you for your continued attention to the financial needs of the church.

It is with great excitement we turn the calendar toward the school year and a change of season at church. On August 13, we will celebrate "Backpack Sunday"! Lots going on, including children singing at 9am & 11am, prayers for the school year, keychains for students' backpacks, free books to go along with new sermon series, and Sunday School promotion. As the school year restarts and summer travel winds down, we look forward to seeing you in church! The FUMC Staff and Church Leaders have been planning an exciting and busy Fall. See you soon!

About 20 women participated in a painting event led by Allie Robbins in July. More women's events are upcoming—we will share details as they are available.












BACK TO SCHOOL SUNDAY

This will be a big Sunday for our children and youth! On Sunday, August 13, we will have prayers for all students, schools and educators in each service. A NOTE FROM Pastor Sarah

Hello church!

This summer during Sunday morning worship, we've studied several of Jesus' teachings in the gospel of Matthew. A few weeks ago, I came across this verse in Matthew 13:52:

"Every scribe who has become a disciple in the kingdom of heaven is like the master of a household who brings out of his treasure what is new and what is old."

The Message translation puts it this way:

"You see how every student well-trained in God's kingdom is like the owner of a general store who can put his hands on anything you need, old or new, exactly when you need it."

As someone who just moved a family of 5 into a new space, I can relate to this on a tangible level. Suddenly, everything I own has a new home! I can't just automatically find anything in its usual place! Habits are an important part of everyday life, and all of our habits were shuffled around. We are discovering a new neighborhood and finding new favorites for eating, shopping, and everything else. (I'd love to hear your recommendations.) The kids



are joining new sports teams and dance classes. And of course, we have been getting to know everyone here at our new Church. It's been a lot of fun, and it's also tiring!

On a deeper level, Jesus is talking about treasuring and making the most of both what is new and what is old. Some of us have an easy time valuing what already is but struggle to imagine what could be. Others have abundant vision for the future but forget to value the heritage and hard work that brought us to this day. As a faith community, we value the traditions and stories and people who've gone before and shaped who we are. We find comfort in knowing that God never changes. At the same time, we make space to treasure what is new - what is now. God builds new things on the foundation of the old. New people and new callings come into the fold. God invites us to remember we are "never too old to set another goal or to dream a new dream." (C.S. Lewis said that!)

Whether this is a season of newness and change for you, or a time of relative sameness - God invites you to bring your full self in submission to and service for God's Kingdom. I look forward to serving the Kingdom with you in the coming year, and I can't wait to get to know you better.
