A Word from Our Pastor

Greetings Paragould First United Methodist Church!

My heart is full!

What a wonderful and rich Holy Week and Easter celebration! A beautiful Easter Sunday filled with friends, fellowship, and powerful worship! This was one of the smoothest and most fun Easter celebrations in some time. We had a great attendance at our Holy Week services. Maybe our biggest Egg Hunt ever! And Easter Sunday was just perfect! Numbers are not everything, but holiday attendance is a strong indication of church involvement and health. Our total attendance on Easter Sunday was 606 (compared to 556 in 2023)! Awesome. Super encouraging!

Thank you to everyone including staff and volunteers who put in extra hours this past week and month. From Choir and Band and Handbells and Soloists. To candy donations and egg-stuffers and youth hiding eggs. To extra hospitality volunteers. Children and Youth leaders. Any one and every one who pitched in. THANK YOU! The Easter Celebration continues!

Easter-tide is a 50 day celebration of Easter! Continue to bring your Easter energy to worship the next few weeks!

Our spirit of celebration continued with Confirmation Sunday (April 7). Wow! What an awesome day of worship as we welcomed 13 Confirmands and new church members including five baptisms. Confirmation is a place where the young people discover who Jesus is to them and what faith looks like in their lives. Confirmation should be the foundation to a lifetime of discipleship. Students learn Christian theology, learn the nature of the church, and explore their faith commitments, but they also need to find ways to integrate all of it into their everyday lives. Confirmation and baptism are inextricably connected. Many confirmands are baptized as babies or young children. Each student baptized as a child who chooses to complete confirmation declares for herself or himself trust in Christ, thereby embracing God's promise of salvation made in baptism. Confirmands who were not already, are baptized as part of the Confirmation worship service.

You can see pictures and read the names of Confirmands included herein. Please continue to support these young people as they move into Youth in the coming year! What an awesome group of children and families. Thank you to everyone who supported Confirmation this year. We also welcomed new member Toni Bazzell and shared in her baptism on Sunday, April 7! Welcome, Toni!

make summer plans! Lots going on at FUMC the next few months!

The United Methodist Church will meet for General Conference April 23 through May 4 in Charlotte, North Carolina. The General Conference is our global gathering of equal numbers of United Methodist pastors and lay delegates (750+ total). General Conference meets every four years and is the governing body for the denomination. FUMC shared in an information session regarding General Conference Sunday, March 24. Copies of the handout are available in the church office. The Arkansas Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church will meet June 19-21 in Hot Springs. Both pastors will attend alongside FUMC delegates Gene Weeks and Susie Cook. I anticipate a follow-up information session on the state of the UMC and Conference later this summer. Please hold our denomination and church in prayer now and all times.

Finally, I offer a brief reflection on our capital needs and future. We have done minimal work on the facility thus far in 2024 outside of the organ repairs. We give thanks for Colby Organs for making a few return trips to finalize all the details. The organ appears to be working (and sounding!) great! We replaced a small water heater on the first floor last month. We always have more we could be doing, but we are not tackling any significant projects on campus. With regard to finances, we are holding our own. General giving YTD is 225,533 (vs. 221,765 in 2023). Building/Next 100 YTD is 144,559 (vs. 165,401). Admittedly, we had a down February, but giving was strong in March and we are back to "normal" for the year. As always, I thank you for your consistent financial support of FUMC and its ministries. Youth pastors, staff, and Finance Cmte will continue to be careful and thorough in managing our financial resources and future in accordance with God's will for our church.

Again, this season of Easter and Confirmation brings such joy and energy to church! I am feeling so grateful for the shared work around this holy season including this year's Confirmation class. I sense a joyful presence of God's spirit at work at FUMC! And look forward to the upcoming season and this summer's ministries! May the Lord bless you and keep you!
